# THE FERC GRID RULE UNDERMINES MARKETS, HURTS CONSUMERS

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) is considering a proposal that could cost consumers more than \$10 billion each year and upend electricity markets. The proposal is opposed by a range of stakeholders across the entire power generation value chain.
